# Paul's Opponents and Champions

### 1. Paul's legacy

Toledot Yeshu (Paul responsible for the establishment of Christianity at the instigation of the rabbis)

Wrede: Paul as the "second founder of Christianity"

For: pervasive presence of Paul in the NT; converts and distance travelled; impact on Gentiles and Christianity as a "Gentile religion"; separation from Peter and other apostles

Against: Christians in Antioch, Rome and Africa; much of NT isn't "Pauline"; agreements with Peter and other apostles; Paul's gospel

Badiou and Žižek: creator not only of Christianity, but also of Christ
